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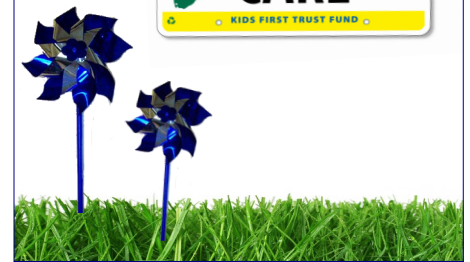

What is the Community Partners for Child Safety Program?

Community Partners for Child Safety is a free, voluntary service to help parents! Parenting can be a struggle and at times assistance is needed. Community Partners for Child Safety can be that assistance through difficult times.

Community Partners for Child Safety aims to keep children safe from abuse and neglect and to support families so that parents can be the best they can be!

Families Will Receive Assistance Through:

- Home-Based Services
- On-call Availability
- Crisis Intervention Counseling
- Timely, Effective, and Appropriate Prevention Support Services
- Development of Family Case Plans to Include 3 Goals
- Referrals to Resources and Supports Within the Community
- Support and Advocacy Services

Who can be a Part of This Program?

Families who reside in Clark, Floyd, Harrison, Scott or Washington counties. Children and families who are not currently DCS wards, Informally Adjusted or involved with Juvenile Probation. Families may self refer or be referred by another person or agency.

Home -Based Roles Are:

- Home-Based Therapy
- Family Counseling
- Case Management
- Juvenile Mentoring
- Parenting
- Community Resourcing

How Long Does it Last?

Families can remain in the program for up to 3 months but service can be renewed once goals are reached.

This program is free to families.
